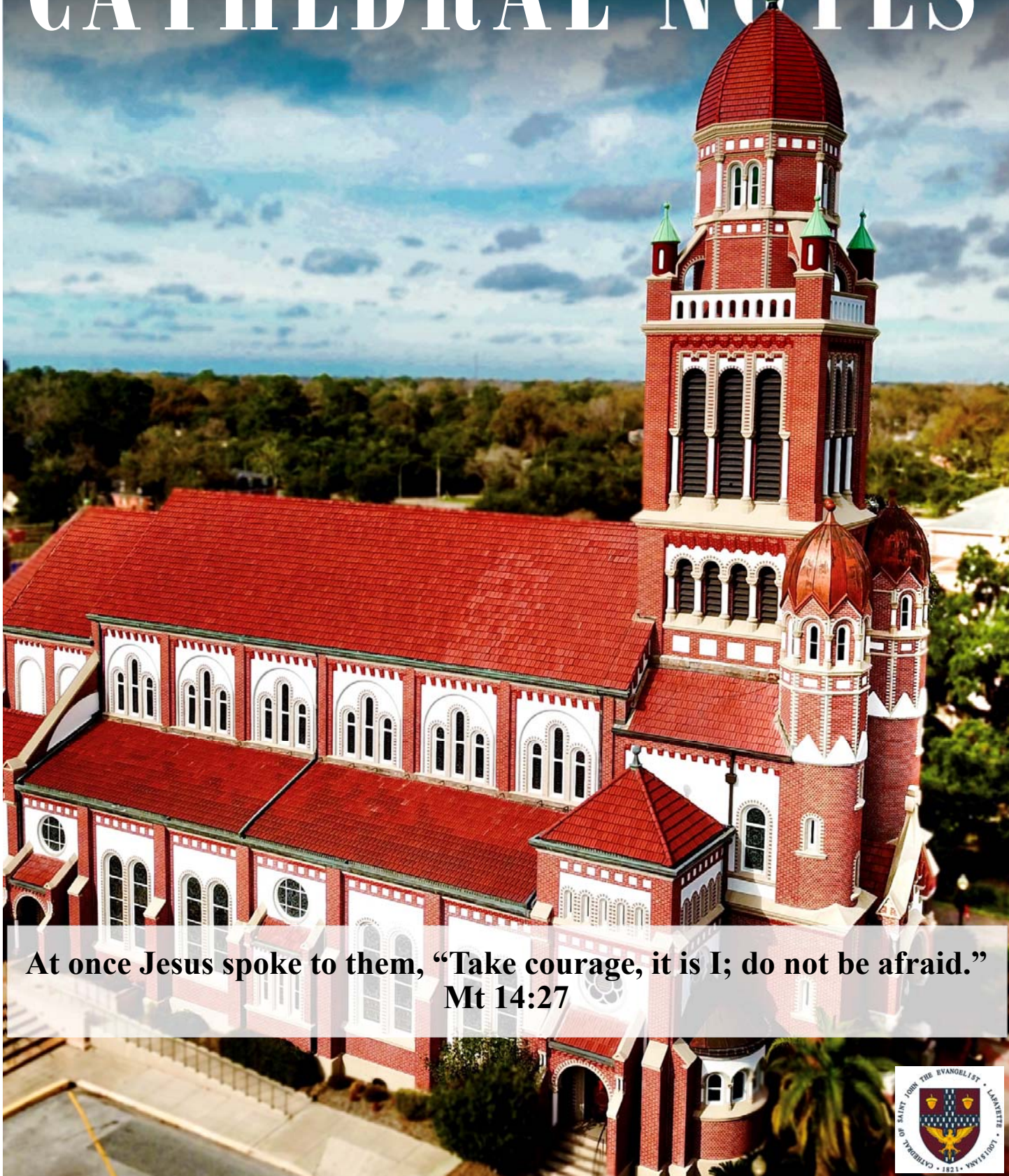

### Nineteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

**Today's Gospel reveals what miraculous things can happen when one embraces a single-minded faith in Jesus Christ. Peter gets out of a wind-tossed boat when the Lord calls him. His faith is tested by his obedience to Jesus who is calling him out onto the water. In the midst of the waves and the wind, Peter gets out of the boat and walks toward Jesus.**

## The Year of Saint Joseph Prayer Service

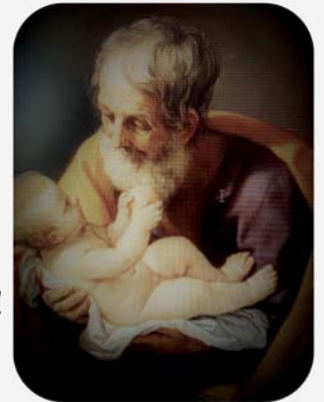
The Diocese of Lafayette is planning two big events to kick-off the celebration for the Year of Saint Joseph.
