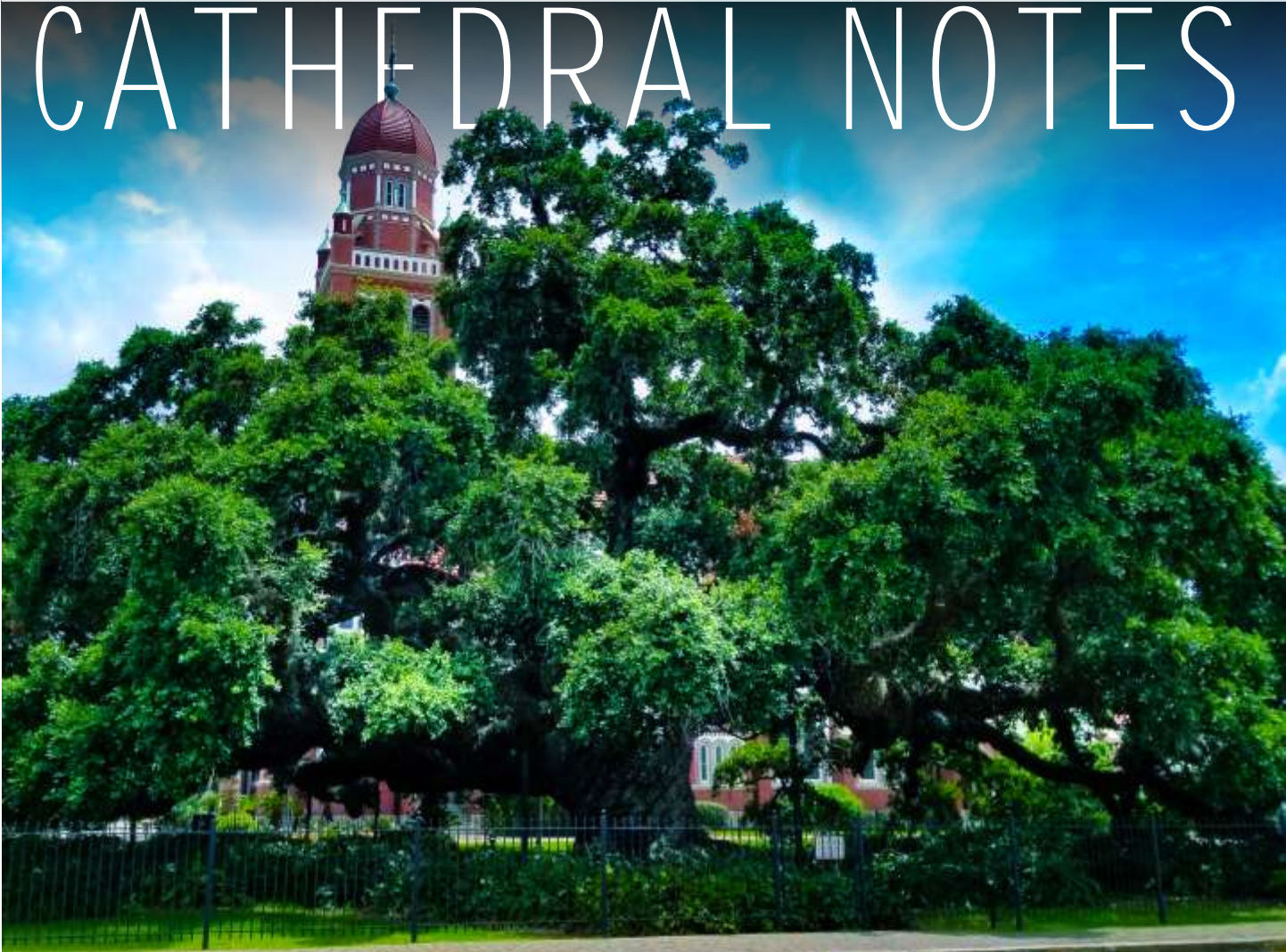

A Message from Fr. Arceneaux



My Dear Parishioners:

This weekend we laid one of our parishioners to rest, Former Governor Kathleen Babineaux Blanco. I offer my condolences to the family and friends of Governor Blanco and ask for continued prayers for the eternal rest of her soul.

This week has been filled with moments of faith from the citizens of Louisiana. As I attended the events in Baton Rouge and was blessed to preside at the funeral on Saturday in Lafayette, I was so moved by the faith of the people of this great state. Governor Blanco was first and foremost a woman of faith, and the events that honored her life honored our faith in God which determined every aspect of her life and public service.

In the Gospel from Luke for today, Jesus tells us to cling to him in faith, for he is the only way of salvation. I ask you today, how are you sharing your faith with others? 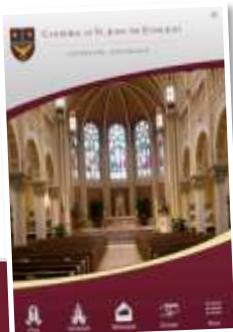

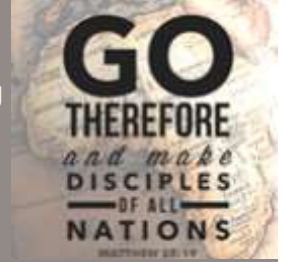

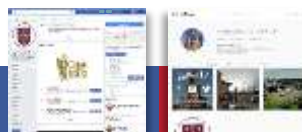
