A Message from Fr. Arceneaux

My Dear Parishioners:

In our Gospel today from Luke, our Lord taught us about one of the most important virtues of our lives: humility. This virtue is so important because pride, ego, self-righteousness, vanity, and many other vices are a constant temptation for us. We are often inclined to think ourselves great and worthy of praise, rather than to direct all praise to God.

Through the parable Jesus gave us we are encouraged to “take the lowest place”. This is exactly what our Lord did. Although he is in the highest place as God, he lowered himself to the point of the Cross. How much more should we lower ourselves, we who claim to follow him?

In our family, do we take the lowest place? At work, do we take the lowest place? In this Church community, do we take the lowest place? Humility is not about putting ourselves down. Humility is about placing God on high and looking for opportunities to raise others up instead of ourselves.

This week, let us all ask God for the great gift of humility.

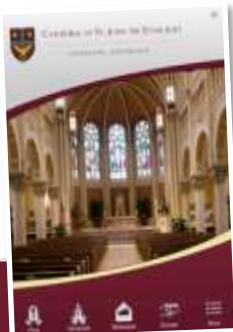

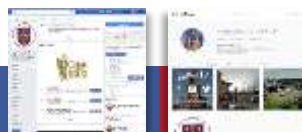

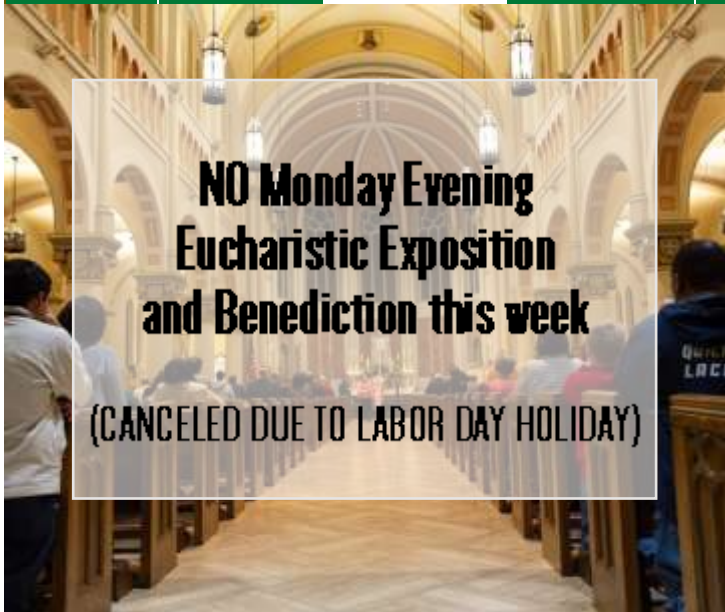
