After nearly 200 years of service, Historic St. John Cemetery, located on the beautiful grounds of The Cathedral of St. John the Evangelist is nearly out of property. To help increase the number of families the remaining space can serve, it was decided to build an addition to the present mausoleum. The addition will include both interior and exterior spaces for both traditional burial along with spaces for cremation. The interior spaces will be located in "Resurrection Chapel" a beautiful, climate controlled chapel that will be available for burial services, visitation and other special services.

St. John the Evangelist has entered into an agreement with American Cemetery Consultants LLC of New Orleans to conduct a survey to determine the amount of spaces we will build in the mausoleum. After the survey is completed, and the final size has been determined, the firm will begin the construction phase of the program.

The new "Resurrection Chapel Mausoleum" and its addition will be designed and constructed so that it will be standing for centuries to come. The mausoleum will be built with steel reinforced, poured-in-place concrete and finished with the finest materials and select granites.
